very important factor given that female fertility shows a strong negative correlation with increasing age.

Treatments available

In Vitro Fertilisation:

The aim is to induce the ovaries to respond to hormonal medication so that a satisfactory number of follicles can develop.

Ovulation Induction:

Administration of pills and a low dosage of hormone injections is used to induce the maturation of one or a small number of follicles assumed each to contain an egg.

Intrauterine Insemination (IUI): a semen

Sperm Cryopreservation: Advisable for men that receive reversal or ivasectomy or irreversal Treatment against testicular cancer

Pre-implantation genetic testing (PGS) is the technique emspecimen produced by the male partner is processed for separating and activating the motile spermatozoa from the rest constituents of the ejaculate.

Testicular Sperm Extraction spermatozoa are retrieved from the testes using a very fine aspiration needle.

contribution and renounce liability of the
eggs donated in written consent forms.
